Irmgard Hainz was a much liked member of the GEA for so many years. She participated in different events like dinners, concerts, cross country skiing, mountain hikes, country walks, wine evenings, beer-garden visits, trips to Gardasee, etc.

In recent times we did not see her so much anymore. The reason is now easy to understand: she was battling cancer for the last ten years but did not want to encourage sympathy. Instead, she appreciated being treated like a healthy person.

The knowledge that she would not be with us much longer allowed Irmgard to plan all that would be involved with her death (30 March 2019). That included picking her final resting place: a small spot in the Parkfriedhof in Ottobrunn on a lawn under a small boulder.

Irmgard was one of a kind, always friendly, well organized, disciplined, with never a bad word to say about others. We will miss her. She will stay in our memory; our thoughts are with her and her family.
